1. REGISTRATION FOR THE WORKSHOP

Many of you have indicated participation of other persons from your institute. They will also need to register **without selecting an ID**. Instead of ID they have to fill in the cells left white in the spreadsheet. The participation fee for those who have not paid the participation fee and have not prepared the intercomparison is

EUR 220. Please note that by completing the invoice data, additional participants acknowledge the requirement to pay the fee.

The deadline for receipt the fee is 30 April.

3.1. ACCOMODATION

Participants are suggested to book a hotel room in the Radisson Hotel Budapest BudaPart, according to the arrival and departure dates of the arranged travel. A booking link to the hotel will be sent to all participants soon and separately.

In Radisson Hotel Budapest BudaPart the check-in time starts from 15:00 (03:00 PM) at the day of arrival, check-out on the day of departure is possible until 11:00 AM. Early check-in can be requested individually at the hotel for additional cost.

Please note that only cashless payment is accepted at the hotel.

3.2. MEALS

In the mornings and in the afternoons, coffee breaks will be held with hot beverages and pastries. (See the Preliminary programme of ICIDOSE#2 Workshop.)

All Participants are invited to the Gala dinner at the organizers' expense held on the evening of Thuesday, 13 May. The dinner will be held on an event boat, which will take us for a river cruise on the Danube. The port is about 800 m from the hotel, but about the meeting you will be informed in due time.

3.3. GET-TOGETHER PROGRAMME

Monday evening, for those who have already arrived at the hotel, we are planning an informal, self-catered get-together at a nearby restaurant. Please use the registration form on the <u>website</u> to indicate if you wish to join.

3.4. TRAVELLING - GETTING TO THE HOTEL FROM

3.4.1. THE AIRPORT

Transports on arrival from the Budapest Airport (website: https://www.bud.hu/en) to the Radisson Hotel Budapest BudaPart (address: Dombóvári út 25A, 1117 Budapest) or Budapest city center and on departure to the airport have to be arranged individually.

Budapest Airport is located 23-24 km South-East from the city center of Budapest, which can be easily reached by taxi, shuttle transfer, public transportation.

TAXI

The easiest and most convenient way to reach the hotel is by taxi. There are several taxi companies, but Főtaxi (phone number: +36 1 222 2222; website: https://fotaxi.hu/en/) is the preferred company at the airport as other companies' cars have to be booked in advance or by phone. **Reservations can be made in person at the Főtaxi stands, located at the exits of airport terminals 2A and 2B.** Taxis parked at the taxi rank in front of the stands are continuously waiting for passengers.

In Hungary, the price of a taxi ride is regulated by the Taxi Decree setting a fixed tariff of 440 HUF/km ($^{\sim}1,10$ EUR/km) in addition to a one-off basic fee of 1100 HUF ($^{\sim}2,57$ EUR) and a waiting fee. A typical fare from the airport is around 11 000 – 12 000 HUF ($^{\sim}27$ – 30 EUR), depending on traffic conditions. See the <u>toll</u> <u>calculator</u>.

All taxis are typically equipped with a POS terminal, so credit cards are also accepted.

Please be aware of exposing yourself to risk by using non-regulated taxi service providers soliciting at the terminal buildings.

AIRPORT SHUTTLE TRANSFER

The miniBUD airport shuttle (website: https://www.minibud.hu/) is the official airport shuttle service provider for Budapest Airport and a convenient, fast and affordable transfer service between the airport and the city.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

The fastest route from Budapest Airport to the Radisson Hotel Budapest BudaPart using public transportation can be found on the following <u>link</u>.

A direct bus line (bus number 100E) connects the airport with the city center with a final station at the airport called "Liszt Ferenc Airport 2". For bus 100E, a special ticket has to be purchased from the BKK ticket vending machines (see instructions on the website: https://bkk.hu/en/tickets-and-passes/ticket-vending-machines-tvm/), from the mobile phone app (https://bkk.hu/en/tickets-and-passes/budapestgo/), or from the bus driver at a cost of 1500 HUF (~4 EUR).

3.4.2 THE RAILWAY STATION

- The railway arrives at KELETI PÁLYAUDVAR: please get off at KELENFÖLDI PÁLYAUDVAR!
 Transport from Kelenföldi Pályaudvar to the Radisson Hotel Budapest BudaPart with public transportation will take only about 20 minutes please follow the <u>link</u>.
- The railway arrives at DÉLI PÁLYAUDVAR:
 - please get off at KELENFÖLDI PÁLYAUDVAR! Transport from Kelenföldi Pályaudvar to the Radisson Hotel Budapest BudaPart with public transportation will take only about 20 minutes – please follow the link.
 - o from **Déli Pályaudvar** the route to the hotel by public transport is also easy.

 The railway arrives at NYUGATI PÁLYAUDVAR: Transport from Nyugati Pályaudvar to the Radisson Hotel Budapest BudaPart with public transportation will take about only 30 minutes – please follow the link.

5.1. LOCAL CURRENCY

The Hungarian currency is Hungarian Forint (HUF).

1 EUR = 399,43 HUF

1 USD = 381,24 HUF

In many of the shops or restaurants in Budapest, credit or debit card is accepted. There are also international ATMs around the city where you can withdraw cash with different kinds of credit or debit cards. Please keep in mind that different exchange rates may apply when using ATMs or payment by card.

Nevertheless, it is advisable to carry some cash in case the card is failed to be used for any reason.

5.2. PUBLIC SAFETY

Budapest is a safe Hungarian city where you will not face serious crimes. However, robberies and pickpocketing occur sometimes. Watch your belongings and if possible do not carry valuables while walking around the city.

Taxi services are safe and widespread. The public transport is safe but be aware of pickpockets.

ATM card fraud is possible, especially in tourist locations. Try to withdraw money from ATMs located at the banks. Sometimes you can be deceived with the quality of souvenirs, selling fakes. Buy tickets to museums and festivals only at licensed sale points to avoid being scammed.
